

The event, organised by the Centro de Investigaciones Energéticas, Medioambientales y Tecnológicas (CIEMAT) and the University of Córdoba, will be held at the Córdoba Conference and Exhibition Center (Palacio de Congresos), a beautiful 16th-century building located in the heart of Córdoba's old town, just steps away from the renowned Mosque-Cathedral of Córdoba, a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1984.
